We would like to inform you that the **Société d'habitation de la sclérose en plaques**, a nonprofit organization that was founded in 1984 and is completely separate from MS Canada – Quebec Division, has sold its building located at **11100 Notre-Dame Street East in Montréal-Est** to **Gérer son quartier**, a social economy organization founded in 1996, specializing in community real estate management.

The Société d'habitation de la sclérose en plaques' mission was to offer an affordable housing project to people with multiple sclerosis living on a low income. Gérer son quartier has managed the building since 2015 and is thus very familiar with the premises and the living environment of the tenants, making it a buyer of choice. The organization is committed to keeping the building's initial mission while maintaining the acquired rights of the current residents.

As stipulated in its general rules, once the Société d'habitation de la sclérose en plaques is dissolved, the proceeds from the sale will go to **MS Canada – Quebec Division**. The Quebec Division is committed to managing these proceeds responsibly and transparently, in accordance with its mission and with MS Canada's ownership of buildings policy. This commitment is demonstrated through research support, direct services to people living with multiple sclerosis and their loved ones, as well as initiatives to raise awareness of the cause and its visibility in Quebec.
